

- Learn how to assess and treat children, adolescents, and families utilizing one tool that can be tailored toward both specific presenting problems and diverse populations





What is a Genogram?

- · A diagram of a client's context, which might include:
 - Current family systemFamily historyMedical history

 - Racial and cultural background
 - Relational dynamics
 - Environmental influences

Therapeutic Powers of Play

- ■Therapeutic Factor: Abreaction



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Combining Play with Genograms

- · It can be used with multiple generations
- · Grandparents and grandchildren can participate
- Family members choose miniatures or puppets to represent people in the family
- This adds richness to the description of the family members when the children describe why a certain animal represents a family member

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Combining Play with Genograms


- Play genograms enhance an already well-established assessment tool
- It gives the client an alternative language to expand on family history
- · It doesn't rely on verbal communication
- · Children may find it easier to share if using miniatures


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

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Case Study: Background Information

- Jacob (8 years old) presented to counseling to help ease transitions to new home, school, and town Jacob lives with biological mother and has visitation with his paternal grandma and grandpa
- Jacob's dad died of a drug overdose when Jacob was 6 years old. Jacob was present for the overdose and called his mom for help
- Mom decided to move to her hometown to be closer to her family. The Paternal grandparents became upset and filed for visitation rights


Case Study: Potential Questions

- Who are you closest to in the family?
- What made you choose those specific animals for each family member?
- How does your family deal with sadness? How do they deal with death?
- How does your family celebrate holidays? How do you decide where you spend them?
